WE feel that the Balance Sheet overleaf needs a fuller explanation than has been given formerly in its concluding footnote.

For it seems that many are under the impression that we have among us as a Band all that is needed for carrying on and extending the work.

For many years this has ceased to be the case, but God's ways of leading on our faith have been very gentle, and He has often sent in the supply ahead of the demand. Now He is taking us into further-on lessons, and this year again has brought faith-tests that we have never known before, together with beautiful interventions of His resources. We would not walk in any other path!

Never have the openings for advance been so multiplied, never have the visions been so clear as to what might be wrought for God in following them up, for the spirit of hearing is unprecedented. Whether we are again to hold on our way in the direct evangelistic message through the land in this its day of grace, depends no longer on what we can put together of means, but on what God sends in through His people.
