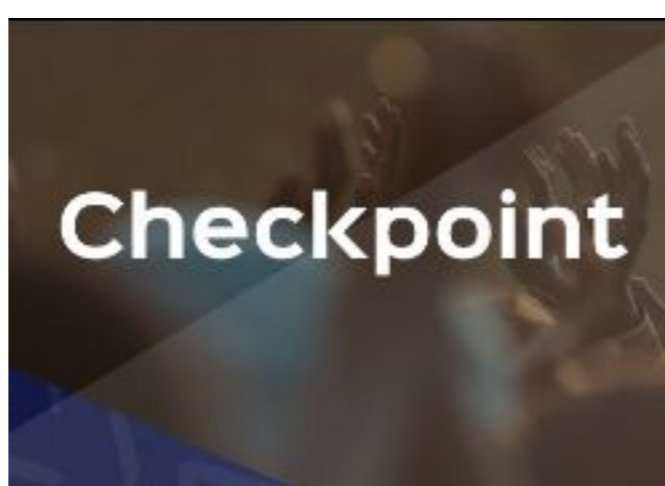

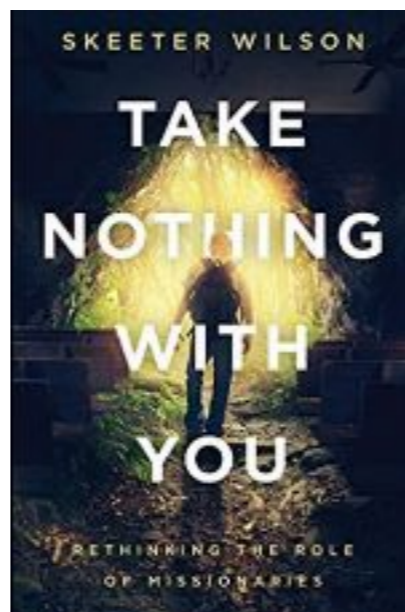

Skeeter Wilson was a mission-kid in Kenya. The way his parents carried out their mission endeavours many decades ago have continued to trouble him. This has culminated in his producing the above book, that came to press in 2020. After much thought and intensive research, Wilson has put together some radical recommendations regarding the future of mission efforts by the West in Africa. He covers a great deal of the ground of the critique of the Alliance for Vulnerable Mission. Instead of advocating, however, that missionaries change radically, he suggests that they go home.

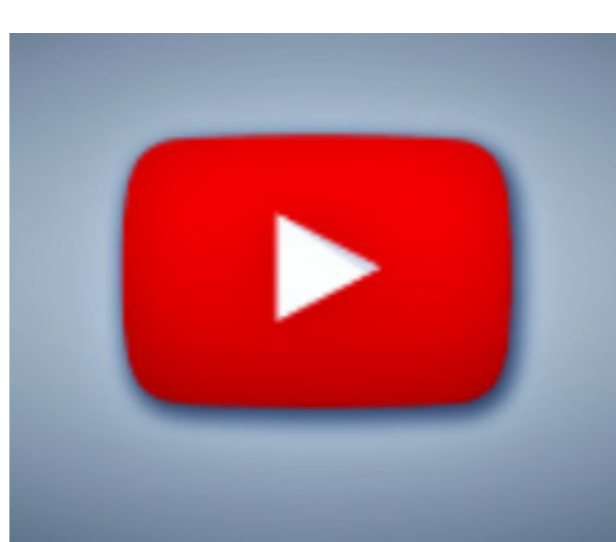


### No personal wish-list prayers
