



Jim was one of about 60 presenters over 4 days of on-line conference 7th to 10th December 2022, on the theme of 'quality (Bible) translation. The event was attended by around 100 people. The vast majority had professional roles in Bible Translation organisations. Jim's paper was the second last in the whole event. His promotion of vulnerability for some Bible Translation projects was well received and caused significant discussion.
